

## Terms and Conditions of Participation in Practical Online Workshops on Hernia Repair Surgery Using Hernia Mesh

1. These Terms and Conditions (hereinafter: T&Cs) set out the rules for participation in practical online workshops on hernia repair surgery using hernia mesh (hereinafter: Workshops), which will be held on 23 March 2026.
2. The organiser of Workshops (hereinafter: Organiser) is Toruńskie Zakłady Materiałów Opatrunkowych Spółka Akcyjna based in Toruń, ul. Żółkiewskiego 20/26, 87-100 Toruń, registered with the District Court in Toruń, VII Division (Commercial) of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0000011286, NIP [Tax ID No] 8790166790, BDO [Packaging Waste Database No] 000013635, share capital: PLN 2,640,000, including paid up capital: PLN 2,640,000; with the participation of the SIA "TZMO Latvija" Reinvaldu iela 17, Riga, LV-1021 and Association "Paula Stradiņa Clinical University Hospital Development Association" Pilsõņu iela 13, Riga, LV 1002
3. The aim of Workshops is to disseminate knowledge among doctors about the possibilities of using hernia meshes, which are commercially offered by Organiser, in hernia repair surgery.
4. Due to the professional medical nature of Workshops, only doctors with a licence to practice medicine can participate in Workshops (hereinafter: Participant).
5. The key part of Workshops will involve Professor Kryspin Mitura, MD PhD, and dr Andrejs Brikuns, MD, performing and discussing hernia repair surgeries at Pauls Stradiņš Clinical University Hospital in Riga. Prof. Kryspin Mitura, MD, PhD will also answer Participants' questions. Participants will take part in Workshops via online streaming on our YouTube channel, and will be able to ask questions via chat.
6. Detailed Workshop agenda is attached to these T&Cs. Organiser reserves the right to deviate from the Workshop agenda if it becomes necessary due to the course of the surgeries.
7. To take part in Workshops, Participants should register by 22 March 2026 by completing a registration form provided by Organiser on <https://mpc.tzmo-global.com/en>, and pay a fee of EUR 16 EUR (sixteen euro) gross (using the cashless online payment system PayU on <https://mpc.tzmo-global.com/en>).
8. Participants may cancel their participation in Workshops up to 4 days before the start at the latest. To cancel, send an email to [mpc.en@tzmo-global.com](mailto:mpc.en@tzmo-global.com) with a declaration that you wish to cancel your participation in Workshops. The organiser will then refund the fee you had paid to the indicated bank account within 14 days.
9. Failure to participate in Workshops (for reasons not attributable to Organiser) without prior cancellation in accordance with Section 8 will not entitle Participants to receive a refund of the fee paid.
10. By registering for Workshops and paying the fee (as per Section 7) Participants enter into a contract with Organiser to participate in Workshops subject to these T&Cs, which means that Organiser agrees to enable Participants to take part in Workshops, and Participants may participate in Workshops in accordance with these T&Cs. The contract shall be governed by Polish law.
11. In addition to being able to attend Workshops, Participants who have registered to participate in Workshops and paid the fee (as per Section 7) will also get:
  - a) the possibility of replaying video recordings of Workshops on <https://mpc.tzmo-global.com/en> for a period of 7 days from the end of Workshops;
  - b) a certificate (in PDF format, emailed to the address provided by Participant) confirming participation in Workshops.
12. Participants are obliged to participate in Workshops in a lawful and respectful manner.
13. Organiser is not responsible for any disruptions to Participants' participation in Workshops (in particular inability to gain access to online streaming or interruptions in online streaming, inability to ask questions via chat, etc.) due to technical issues or limitations caused by computer hardware, terminal equipment, ICT system or telecommunications infrastructure used by Participants.
14. Participants provide their free-of-charge consent for Organiser to record Workshops in the form of video recordings, including Participants' questions asked via chat, and to edit these video recordings as well as to distribute them in any form, without any limitations as regards time or territory.
15. For the avoidance of doubt, Organiser wishes to clarify that registering for and participating in Workshops, including payment of the fee referred to in Section 7, does not mean that Participants

are opening an account and obtaining access to the Medical Practise Center online portal operated by Organiser.

16. Organiser processes the personal data of Participants provided to Organiser and therefore wishes to inform Participants that:
  - a) Personal data are processed in accordance with applicable law, in particular Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter: GDPR).
  - b) The controller of these personal data is Organiser — Toruńskie Zakłady Materiałów Opatrunkowych Spółka Akcyjna, ul. Żółkiewskiego 20/26, 87-100 Toruń.
  - c) The legal basis for the processing of these personal data is Article 6(1)(a) GDPR: the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.
  - d) The personal data is processed for the purpose of:
    - Participants' participation in Workshops and enabling this participation;
    - Organiser's marketing activities, which involve delivering commercial information, publications, and marketing communication (where the Participant has given additional consent).
  - e) The recipients of personal data are persons employed by Organiser and other trusted entities cooperating with Organiser — to the extent necessary to achieve the objectives of that processing; personal data may also be made available to public authorities and other entities which have the legal right to obtain them, at their request.
  - f) The personal data will not be transferred to any third countries or international organizations.
  - g) The personal data will be stored until the above objectives of processing have been achieved.
  - h) Participants have the right to request access to their personal data from Organiser and, in the cases specified in GDPR, to data rectification, portability, erasure, and restriction of processing.
  - i) Participants have the right to withdraw their consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal; consent may be withdrawn by, for example, sending a consent withdrawal statement to the email address <https://mpc-tzmo-global.com/en>.
  - j) Participants have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if they believe that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of GDPR.
  - k) Providing personal data is not a statutory or contractual requirement and is completely voluntary; however, failure to provide data makes it impossible to achieve the above objectives of data processing, namely it prevents Participants from participating in Workshops and prevents Organiser from delivering marketing activities to Participants.
  - l) In connection with the processing of personal data, no automated decision-making, including profiling, is taking place.
  - m) In matters relating to the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to the processing of personal data, Participants may contact the data protection officer: Toruńskie Zakłady Materiałów Opatrunkowych S.A., ul.
